Dear Sacred Heart Family,

Over the next five weeks, the Sunday Gospels will come from John, Chapter 6. This chapter contains the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves as well as Jesus' "Bread of Life" discourse, where our Lord reveals that he will give his own flesh and blood for us to eat in the Eucharist. So for the next five weeks, I will use this column to write briefly about the different parts of the Mass, where we continue to celebrate and receive the Eucharist.

Before looking at the parts of the Mass, it is important to remember that what we do at a Catholic Mass is the same as what was done in the very early Church. St. Justin Martyr wrote to a friend in the year 155 AD the following, and as you can see, he would immediately recognize what we do every Sunday. He wrote: *On the day we call the day of the sun, all who dwell in the city or country gather in the same place. The memoirs of the apostles and the writings of the prophets are read, as much as time permits. When the reader has finished, he who presides over those gathered admonishes and challenges them to imitate these beautiful things. Then we all rise together and offer prayers for ourselves and for all others, wherever they may be. When the prayers are concluded we exchange the kiss. Then someone brings bread and a cup of water and wine mixed together to him who presides over the brethren. He takes them and offers praise and glory to the Father of the universe, through the name of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and for a considerable time he gives thanks [in Greek: eucharistian] that we have been judged worthy of these gifts. When he has concluded the prayers and thanksgivings, all present give voice to an acclamation by saying: 'Amen.' And there is a distribution to each, and to those who are absent a portion is sent by the deacons... And this food is called among us the Eucharist, of which no one is allowed to partake but the man who believes that the things which we teach are true... we have been taught that the food which is blessed by the prayer of His word...is the flesh and blood of that Jesus who was made flesh.* What a comfort to know that we in the year 2015 continue in the long and faithful tradition of so many who have gone before us!
