A third party is taking care of washing and drying the linens after our hosting week. But assistance is needed to wash and dry hand towels and wash cloths on Tuesday and Friday mornings.

Male and Female monitors (18 yrs of age or older) are needed to provide general oversight of guests between the hours of 5:45 p.m. through 7:15 a.m. each day. Shifts have been broken down from 6:00 p.m. to midnight, midnight to 7:15 a.m. We can work with your schedule if you are not able to volunteer for a whole shift.
