WARM DONATIONS WARM: (Wrapping Arms 'Round Many) is an interfaith non-profit organization that provides safe and welcoming shelter during the nights of the coldest months of the year (November – March) to men and women impacted by homelessness. This program enlists churches and other organizations in St. Mary's County to host the homeless for one week. Holy Angels/Sacred Heart's WARM Hosting week is Sunday, January 24th, thru Sunday, January 31st. Due to the pandemic, the WARM Program is not housing the homeless at each of the churches this season. So, Holy Angels/Sacred Heart Church's will not be physically hosting WARM this season. Three Oaks has opened up a couple more shelters and has started a Street Outreach Program to assist the homeless. While Three Oaks has received some small grants for their efforts, the grants do not provide enough funding for all the food and supplies needed to provide three meals a day for approximately 30 homeless guests. This year, we will be donating the unprepared food and supplies, that we would have needed for our hosting week, to the Three Oaks Center. Please make your donation by Thursday, January 21st. Make checks payable to Holy Angels Church with "WARM" in the memo section or provide an envelope marked "WARM" with your donation. All donations should include your envelope number for tax deduction purposes.
