**FR. WYBLE'S SERIES ON THE 7 DEADLY SINS & 7 HEAVENLY VIRTUES** will continue this Tuesday evening, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, from 6 – 7 pm at Sacred Heart Church. This Tuesday's topic will be on the sin of anger and the virtue of forgiveness.

**LENTEN REGULATIONS:** Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence, we fast by eating only one full meal and two smaller meals, and abstain from eating meat. All Catholics from age 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and those age 14 and up are obliged to abstain from eating meat every Friday during Lent. Those who are not in good health are dispensed.

**SEMINARIAN TREES:** If you haven't already, please take a card with a seminarian name from the trees at the entrance of the church and pray for them. This is a wonderful way to support vocations!

**NEW! 7TH DISTRICT 24/7 CHAPEL:** Starting just in time for Lent, our 7th District Catholic community now has 24/7 access to prayer before Jesus in the tabernacle. #### **PRAYER TO ST. FRANCIS XAVIER**

The remembrance of the favors with which God blessed thee during life and of thy glory after death fills me with joy, and I unite with thee in offering Him my humble tribute of thanksgiving and of praise.
