HOLY WEEK AND EASTER SCHEDULE: Holy Thursday Mass will be offered at 7 p.m. at both Sacred Heart and Holy Angels. Good Friday Liturgy at Sacred Heart will be at 7 p.m. and at 3 p.m. at Holy Angels. Easter Vigil Mass will begin at 8 p.m. at both Sacred Heart and Holy Angels. Easter Sunday will be the normal Mass schedule. The Easter Sunrise Mass at St. Clement's Museum will begin at 6:25 a.m.

LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE: There will be a Lenten Penance Service on Wednesday, March 31st from 5 to 7 pm at Holy Angels Church and Thursday, April 1st from 5 to 7 pm at Sacred Heart Church. There will be a visiting priest for both Penance Services.

GOOD FRIDAY FASTING: All Catholics from age 14 up are obliged to abstain from meat on Good Friday. Catholics ages 18 to 59 are obliged to fast on Good Friday.

GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION: On Good Friday, a collection is taken up in Catholic Churches to support the work of the Franciscans working in the Holy Land. Christians there rely heavily on the help that comes to them during this special collection.

DIVINE MERCY NOVENA begins on Good Friday, April 2nd and concludes on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 11th. Brochures with Novena Prayers are available on the tables near the entrance of the church.
