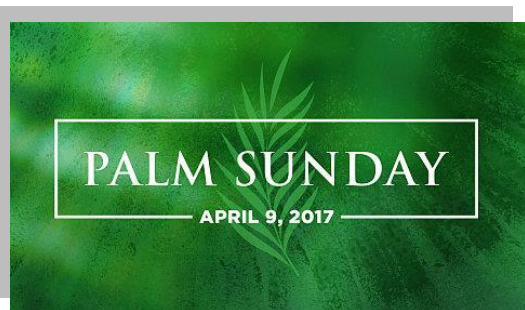
**THANK YOU...**to all those who helped with spring cleaning of our church last Monday!
