**THANK YOU...**to all those who helped changing the Today's Missals last Sunday.

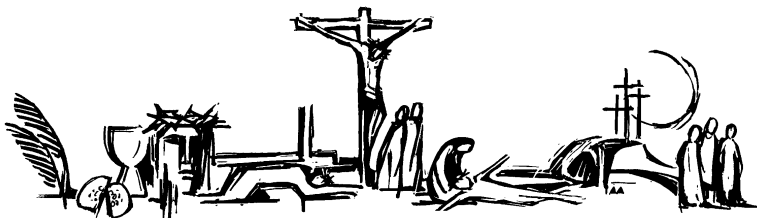
