**IF YOU WANT TO HAVE AN INTENTION HONORED AT MASS...** please visit with Father Bob. When a priest offers mass, he has at least two intentions: First, to offer mass in union with the whole Church and for the good of the whole Church. Second, to offer the mass for a particular intention. This intention is published in the bulletin as an invitation to all who participate to join in praying for the intention. When requesting an intention, it has become customary to make an offering. This offering is symbolic of the sacrifice the person requesting the mass intention is making to associate more closely with the sacrifice of the Mass. The usual offering is \$10 but any offering is acceptable as well as none.
