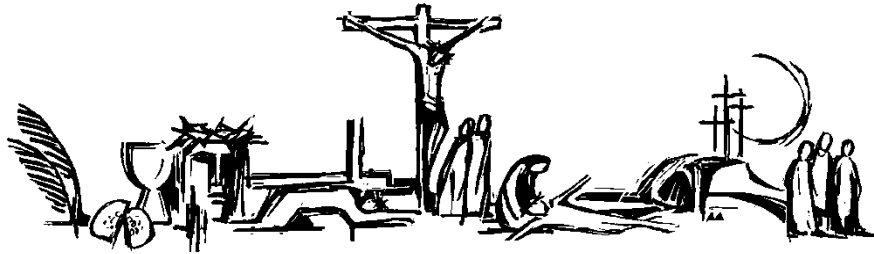

As you process to the Table of the Lord, pray for those who are in the Communion procession with you in our parish and throughout the world.

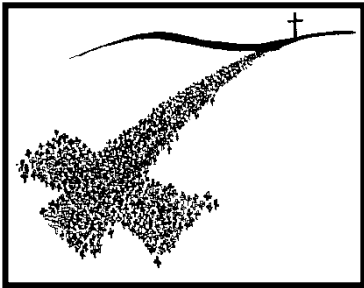


GOOD FRIDAY REFLECTION
