Ultrasound Machines

In 2020, the Knights of Columbus in Kansas were able to help purchase seven new ultrasound machines that were installed here in Kansas. These machines went to pregnancy centers in Goodland, Ottawa, Liberal, Hutchinson, Wyandotte County (2 machines) and Concordia. This is 1/3 of all the machines placed in Kansas since the program began in 2010. There are currently four other clinics in the application process. These locations are Newton, Kansas City, Wichita and Johnson County.

Each of these machines cost the Kansas State Council around \$28,000 for our half of the cost, plus shipping and taxes. The Supreme Council pays for half of the cost of each machine. The State Council needs to continue to raise funds to cover the cost of the machines in the

application process. The proceeds from our Breakfast Burrito Fundraiser will go for this cause.
