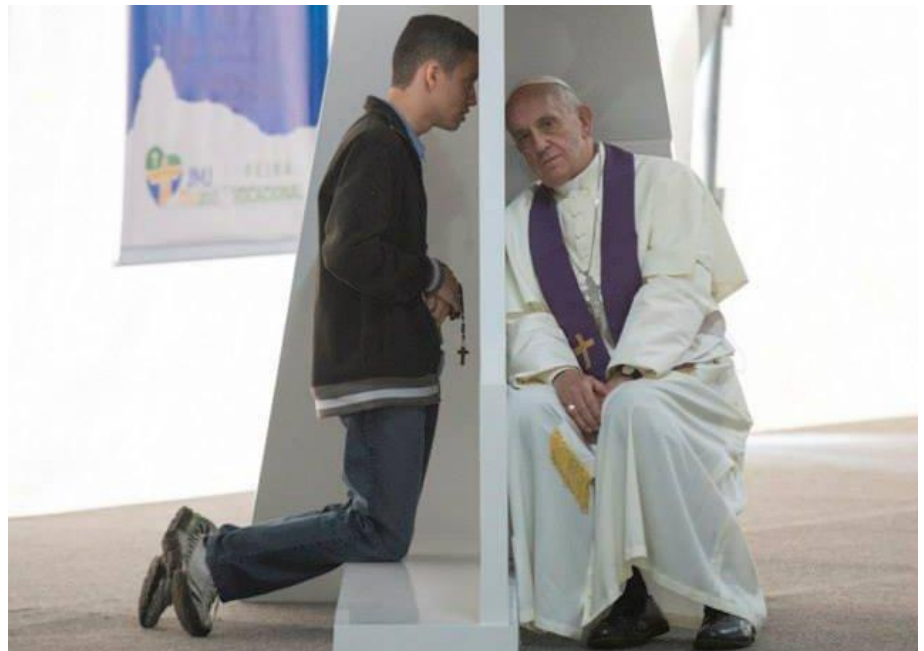

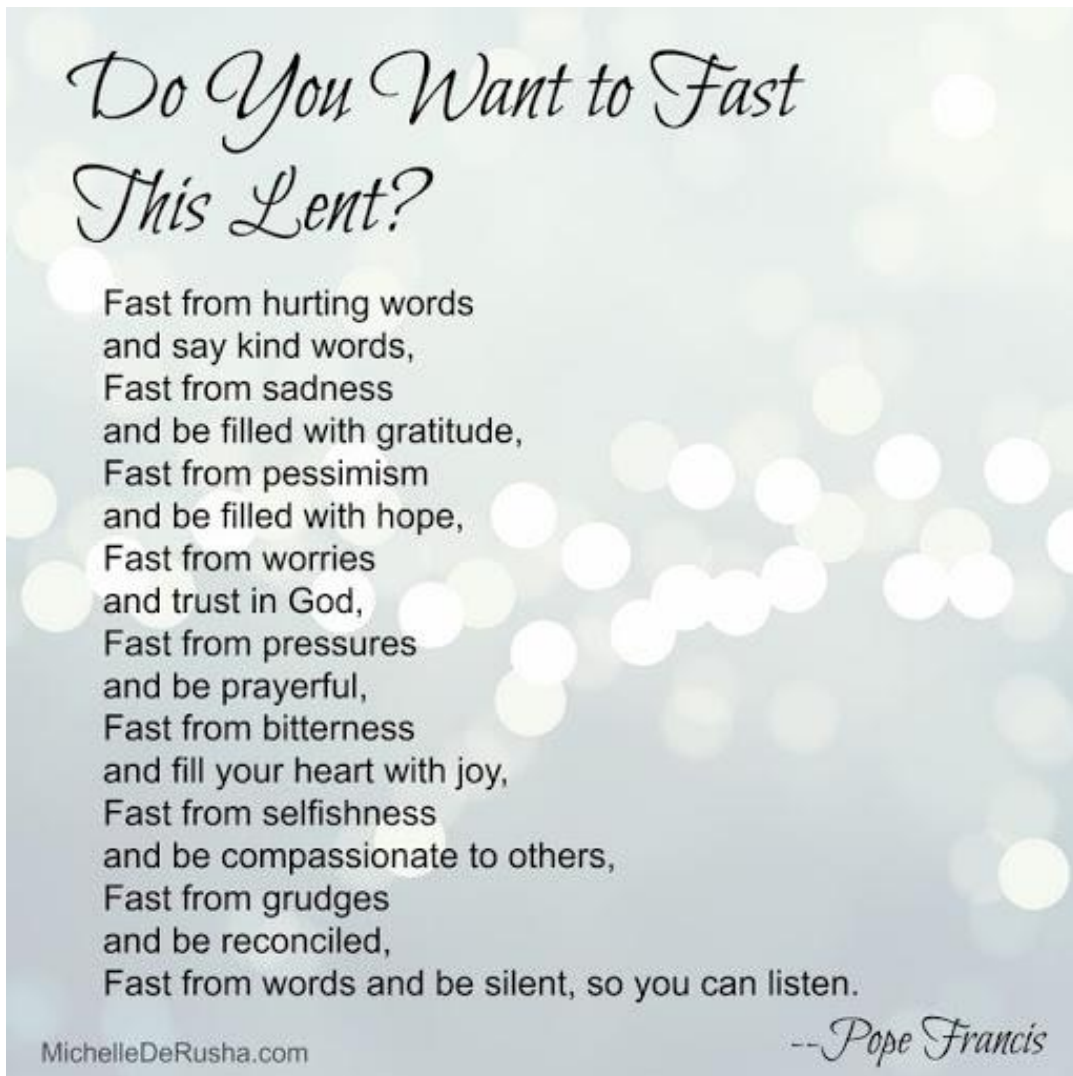
## **Manna House Director**
