Manna House has a few specific needs:

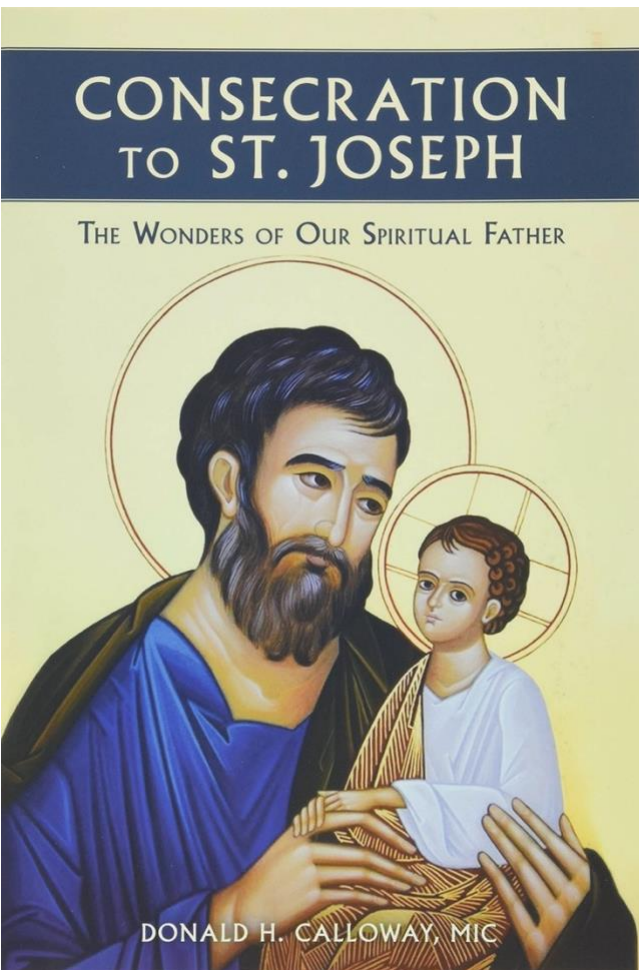
- Peanut butter
