MINISTRY OVERVIEW

Our Lady of Grace Life Teen is a high school youth ministry for 9th-12th grade students that strives to grow one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic church. Life Teen is a program designed by Life Teen International, Inc., which creates Eucharist-centered faith formation resources for Catholic parishes around the world. At Our Lady of Grace, Life Teen encourages students to develop a community of faith and skills for lifelong discipleship. Through small group ministry, mentoring, personal witness, Sacrament, incorporation of current issues, retreats, conferences, Christian service, fellowship, and prayer, we seek to form students into valuable members of their future Catholic communities.

Life Nights

Life Nights are weekly Sunday ministry opportunities during the school year. Nights begin with the celebration of the Eucharist at 5:30pm Sunday Life Teen Mass and continues with fellowship and small group sessions in the Donovan Center. Students are served dinner and then enter into a small group to discuss relevant topics of faith. Over the course of four years, students will learn a curriculum that includes Scripture, Person of Christ, Paschal Mystery, Church, Sacraments, Morality, Catholic Social Teaching, and Vocation. Additionally, each year we will have social nights and issue nights (that focus on a current issue) that connect to reality for our teens.

Leadership

Life Teen is coordinated by Jake Teitgen. Jake is a native of Fishers, Indiana, and is an alumnus of the University of Notre Dame. He has worked at OLG since 2008. He strives to help students see the joy in their Catholic community and seek holiness through authentic faith.

Life Teen is also led by a Core Team of adults who act as models of faith for students. This multigenerational team includes young adults, parents, and priests who desire to share a journey towards God with students.

Retreats & Events

In addition to Life Nights, Life Teen offers many retreats, events, trips, conferences, service opportunities, and activities outside of Sunday nights. We HIGHLY recommend participating in these events as they are regularly praised as highlights for students and launching points for a life of discipleship.
