



CONFIRMATION AT OLG

Confirmation enriches the baptized with the strength of the Holy Spirit so that they can better witness to Christ in word and deed (Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1285). Anointed by the Holy Spirit at Confirmation, Christians strengthen their bond with the Church and become better equipped to carry out the Church's mission of love and service.

INVITATION

*At Confirmation, our faith and membership in the Body of Christ is strengthened. In Baptism, we become new members of the Body of Christ, but our journey does not end there. The decision to be baptized is followed by continued growth, learning, and witness. Our desire to continue to grow and develop as Christians finds expression in Confirmation, when we renew our baptismal promises and receive in a new way the gift of the Holy Spirit, which strengthens our bond with the Church and its members. **We invite you to connect to a Church community, receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit, and be inspired to Gospel action by accepting the Sacrament of Confirmation.***

PREPARATION

Our Lady of Grace invites 10th, 11th, or 12th grade students to participate in the Confirmation preparation ministry. All of our Sacraments begin with a process of preparation so that participants are able to recognize the grace of the Sacrament. Our preparation is generally an 8-month process from September to April. This process includes a student, parents, a Confirmation mentor, Confirmation Sponsor, and our parish leaders.

OPENNESS

In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the Holy Spirit pours love into our hearts so that we become instruments of grace. We encourage all participants to be open to this Spirit and grace. We do not expect that every person who begins the Confirmation preparation process will be perfectly holy or completely dedicated to a life of faith. However, our preparation ministry can lead those who have a desire to grow in faith (or at least an openness to grace) towards an authentic life of discipleship.

CONFIRMATION SPONSOR

Each candidate for Confirmation will be asked to name a Sponsor, who must be a Confirmed Catholic in good standing with the Church. This person must be someone other than the mother or father of the candidate. The sponsor is a mentor, family member, or friend, whom the candidate can consult in matters of faith. Sponsors will accompany a candidate on the day of the Confirmation Liturgy and may be invited to participate in one Confirmation mentor session. If a candidate's Sponsor is unable to attend the Confirmation Liturgy, a proxy can be named for that day. Sponsors from outside the parish will be asked to send a standard letter of good standing from their home parish.

SAINT NAME

Throughout Scripture, many heroes of our faith received new names upon momentous encounters with the Triune God. As well, our Catholic Saints are the holy women and men who inspire us, intercede on behalf of our prayers, and show us routes to holiness. Each Confirmation candidate will choose one Saint to be a patron for him/her as a fully-initiated Catholic. Candidates are encouraged to learn about the life of the Saints in order to make a well-formed choice.

REQUIREMENTS

Our Lady of Grace asks that students and families desiring the Sacrament of Confirmation complete 7 preparation requirements:

1. Register and Turn in Forms for the Sacrament of Confirmation

Registration can be done at ologn.org/formation or via paper form. Forms include:

- (1) Confirmation Intent Form (filled out while registering for Religious Education) by **September 15, 2021**
- (2) Copy of Baptismal Certificate (if NOT baptized at Our Lady of Grace) by **October 15, 2021**
- (3) Parish Commitment Form by **October 15, 2021**
- (4) Sponsor & Saint Name Form (+ Sponsor Certification, if Sponsor is from another parish) by **March 15, 2022**

2. Attend Spirit & Fire Confirmation Retreat (September 24-26, 2021)

This retreat is mandatory and asks parents to participate on Sunday, September 26th.

3. Regularly Attend Sunday Mass

Participating in the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith, and we ask that Confirmation candidates and family, especially during the Confirmation preparation process, join in the weekly celebration of the Eucharist.

Mass Times: (Saturday) 5:30pm | (Sunday) 7:30am | 9:00am | 11:30am | 1:30pm (Spanish) | 5:30pm

4. Meet with Youth Ministry Leadership for 2 Check-Ins

Confirmation Candidates will meet individually with youth ministry leaders for two 15-minute check-in meetings, once near the start of preparation and once during preparation. The purpose of these check-ins is to ensure students are on the right track in their Confirmation preparation process.

5. Participate in Confirmation Mentor Sessions

Each Confirmation candidate will be assigned to a small group and a Confirmation mentor who is an active adult in the parish. These groups will have 6 sessions to discuss the Sacrament of Confirmation and a life of faithful discipleship.

Candidates and mentors will arrange meetings in public locations between October and May (including one session following the Sacrament). The purpose of meeting with Confirmation mentors is to ask students to think critically about faith and gain an adult faith role model.

6. Make a Parish Commitment

At Confirmation, we are sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and strengthened for ongoing service in the Church and in the world. We are called to use these gifts to bear witness to the Christian faith in words accompanied by deeds. During Confirmation preparation, candidates will practice this commitment so as to be ready to serve after Confirmation.

7. Attend Virtual Confirmation Rehearsal (May 18, 2022) and In-Person Liturgy on May 22, 2022.

The Confirmation Rehearsal will take place virtually the week prior to Confirmation. Confirmation candidates and their sponsors are expected to participate in the Confirmation Liturgy.
