

Although we will always have our daily readings for the mass, our intent will be to focus more on the Blessed Mother as we are a Mother of God parish. Please note that the mass intention that was scheduled for 8:00 A.M. will be scheduled for the 7:00 P.M. Mass.

**Also**, we have received approval to add an additional mass on Saturday evenings. Beginning Saturday, September 19th, in addition to our 4:00 P.M. mass, we will also celebrate mass at 6:00 P.M. †

**The Administrative Office**—During this pandemic, the office will continue to be open the normal hours of Monday through Thursday, 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M., and Friday, 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. **Our weekday and weekend mass schedule has been revised—see above calendar** (with guidelines). In addition, St. Mary's will continue to be open for private prayer from 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. daily and 12:00 Noon to 5:00 P.M. on Sundays. Below are the guidelines that are to be followed when visiting our church and what is being done for your safety.

- Wear a mask upon entrance to the church.
- Social distancing must be observed - six feet apart from the next person.
- Only designated pews are to be used for mass/private prayer. For morning and weekend masses, the main doors of the church will be the only way to enter. Greeters and seaters will be at the entrance to greet and seat you. The collection basket will be in the back of the church. When receiving communion, please abide by the markings. This is explained prior to the beginning of each mass. For private prayer, you are to enter at the side entrance.
- There are sanitizers/wipes that are to be used as you enter the church.
- The identified pews and other high contact areas like doorknobs, handles and tables will be sanitized and disinfected twice a day.
- Weekly, each church's high contact areas will be cleaned with soap and water and then sanitized.
- Hymnals and missalettes have been taken out from the pews for your safety.

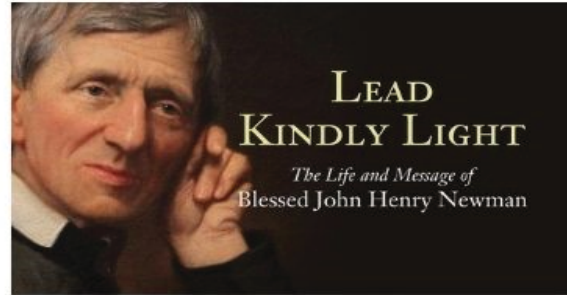

**To Bless or Not to Bless** — "Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless His holy name" (Psalm 103:1). The responsorial Psalm from this week is somewhat of a paradox. How can we, as mere creatures, bless the one who is our Creator? Does this not imply that the one giving the blessing is the greater than the one receiving? It helps us to better understand when we look at the original Hebrew. The word bless or blessed comes from a Hebrew word with two meanings: "bended knee" and a "bubbling spring". First, when we "Bless the Lord" it is as if we are bending our knees before Him in humble adoration and acknowledgement that He has provided everything that we have and enjoy. It also puts us into a position to receive a blessing from Him that will fill us with the graces we may need to fulfill our vocations in life. By directing our blessing towards God our Father, we are expressing our gratitude for the gifts in life that He has lavishly bestowed upon us. Our continued response should then be to live a life of a grateful attitude towards the One who provides us with so many blessings. As an old Jewish proverb states, "If you enjoy something in this world without saying a blessing, it is as if you stole it!" Secondly, when we "bless the Lord" we are reminded of a bubbling spring. As a freshwater spring forms out of the earth, the water begins to well up and create a refreshing pool at the origin. This also should be our response when our spirits bubble up in praise and acknowledgment as we acclaim, "All that is within me, bless His holy name". Let us stir up the wellspring of our gratitude, letting it overflow into beautiful words such as "Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker" (Psalm 95:6). Finally, when we "Bless the Lord" from Psalm 103, we recall why we are doing it in the first place. "The Lord is kind and merciful, slow to anger and rich in compassion" (Ps. 103:8). These words are comforting and consoling to us who tend to drift from the path of the Lord from time to time. But the pinnacle of Psalm 103 is when we hear that the Lord "redeems your life from destruction" (v.4.) This hint of a promise is fulfilled one thousand years later when the "Word became flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:14). Recall to mind that St. James told us that "every good and perfect gift comes from above, coming down from the Father" (James 1:17). So, now we have a Name that is above all other names that we bless and before whom every knee shall bend and every tongue confess that Jesus is our Lord, our Savior, our Redeemer, our ultimate blessing! †
