## FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTION

### Nine consecutive Fridays in reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alocoque (1647 -1690), a French nun in the Visitation Order, and gave her the special task to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart at a time when religion was growing cold in the hearts of mankind.

He said to her:

“Behold this heart which, notwithstanding the burning love for men with which it is consumed and exhausted, meets with no other return from most Christians than sacrilege, contempt, indifference and ingratitude, even in the sacrament of my love [the Eucharist]. But what pierces my heart most deeply is that I am subjected to these insults by persons especially consecrated to my service.”

Jesus asked for special prayers and practices to make amends (reparation) for this great neglect to the proper reverence owed to God. For those who did this faithfully, he made what St. Margaret Mary referred to as the “Great Promise” which was the last and greatest of the Twelve Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

“I promise you in the unfathomable mercy of my heart that my omnipotent love will procure the grace of final penitence for all those who receive communion on nine successive first Fridays of the month; they will not die in my disfavor [the grace of final repentance], or without having received the sacraments, since my divine heart will be their sure refuge in the last moments of their life.”

### CONDITIONS TO FULFILL THE FIRST FRIDAY DEVOTION

The specific conditions to receive the Great Promise of the Sacred Heart of Jesus are:

1. Receive Holy Communion on nine consecutive first Fridays of the month (this assumes that the person is in a state of grace, having made a sacramental confession for any mortal sins prior to receiving communion).
2. Having the intention, at least implicitly, of making reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for all the sinfulness and ingratitude of men.

## Thirty-Second Week in Ordinary Time

On the **Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time**, **Mark's Gospel** has us listen to Jesus contrast a scribe (the professional interpreters of the law in his day) who enjoys honors for himself, with a poor widow who donates to the temple poor box the little she has. The woman's generous heart must have moved him deeply.

Monday is the **Memorial of Saint Josaphat, bishop and martyr**. Tuesday we remember **Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini, Virgin**. Saturday is the **Memorial of Saint Elizabeth of Hungary, religious**.

The first readings this week are from the pastoral letters to **Titus, Philemon**, and the **Second and Third Letter to John**.

Continuing **Luke's Gospel**, we hear Jesus talk about scandal and about forgiveness. He calls us to “have faith the size of a mustard seed” in order to do extraordinary things in his name. Jesus tells us to be obedient to what God calls us to do and simply say, “we have done what we were obliged to do.” We learn a lesson about gratitude when Jesus heals ten lepers and only one, “foreigner” returns to give thanks. Jesus tells the confrontational Pharisees that the Kingdom of God's coming can't be “seen” and it won't be announced. “For behold, the Kingdom of God is among you.” “But first [the Son of Man] must suffer greatly and be rejected by this generation.” All we can do is to be faithful: “Whoever seeks to preserve his life will lose it, but whoever loses it will save it.” Finally, Jesus tells the parable “about the necessity for [his disciples] to pray always without becoming weary.” God will give justice to those who call out to him with faith.

As we near the end of the Liturgical Year, we have more “end time” readings. On the **Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time**, we hear about being ready for the end of time. “In the same way, when you see these things happening, know that he is near, at the gates.” It is the good news that we can stay alert and will be ready when it is our time to recognize the Lord's coming in our own life's challenges today.

**MATRIMONY:** First step is to contact the office to set up an appointment with Fr. Jet.

**BAPTISM:** English baptism classes are held every 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the month at 6:00pm if necessary. Please call the office one week prior to register if you are planning on attending the class. (Classes may be taken before the baby is born.)

### REQUIREMENTS:

- Both Parents and God Parents must attend the Baptism class before the Baptism.
- Godparents are to be (1) fully initiated into the Catholic Church; baptized, received 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation, (2) be at least 16 years old, (3) practicing the faith, and (4) if married - must be in accordance with the Catholic Church.

You will need to come into the office to fill out the proper paperwork and set a date.
