## Third Week of Ordinary Time

The **Third Sunday of Ordinary Time** brings us to a cycle of **Matthew's gospels** that will be used during most Sundays of Ordinary Time this year. This week we see the call of the first disciples as Jesus stops Andrew and his brother, Peter on the beach. "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men'. At once they left their nets and followed him."

Tuesday is the **Memorial of Saint Thomas Aquinas, priest and doctor of the Church**. Friday is the **Memorial of Saint John Bosco**.

This is the third week of readings from Samuel, this week from the **Second Book of Samuel**. A young David is anointed King of Israel and with his army, captures the city of Zion. In the festivities that followed, Samuel offers the delightful image of a joyful David at the Ark of the Covenant, "dancing before the LORD with abandon ... with shouts of joy and to the sound of the horn." The Lord tells David, "I will raise up your heir after you, sprung from your loins, and I will make his Kingdom firm." David sees Bathsheba, the beautiful wife of Uriah the Hittite and after having relations with her, he orders Uriah to the front of a battle where he is killed. Nathan the prophet confronts David, who repents.

In **Mark's Gospel** this week, we have many familiar stories. The scribes, hearing of his many healings, accuse Jesus of being possessed by Satan. He replies that a house is divided against itself cannot stand. Mary and other relatives arrive at a home where Jesus is teaching, but Jesus does not go to them, saying, "Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother." He tells the parable of the sower and the seeds which fall on fertile ground and rocky soil. "Those sown on rich soil are the ones who hear the word and accept it and bear fruit thirty and sixty and a hundredfold." He encourages his disciples not to hide their light "under a bushel basket" and tells the story of the mustard seed, the tiniest seed which grows into one of the largest bushes. In Saturday's gospel the apostles are frightened on a boat in a storm until Jesus awakens to calm the wind and seas.

On the **Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time**, we celebrate the **Feast of the Presentation of the Lord**. It celebrates Mary and Joseph bringing their baby, Jesus, to the temple and their remarkable encounters with both Simeon and Anna. Simeon tells them, "Behold, this child is destined for the fall and rise of many in Israel," while Anna "gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem."

This weekend, January 25-26, is **Commitment Weekend** which is an opportunity to help the Catholic Diocese of Dallas raise necessary funds through the **Bishop's Annual Appeal**. Each year, we commit ourselves to reflect on God's great generosity and respond with a gift of our own that brings others into relationship with Jesus Christ and His Church.

**MATRIMONIO:** El primer paso es ponerse en contacto con la oficina para concertar una cita con el Padre Jet.

- Los padrinos deben ser (1) plenamente iniciados en la Iglesia Católica; bautizados, recibido la 1ª Comunión y Confirmación, (2) tener por lo menos 16 años, (3) practicar la fe, y (4) si están casados - deben estar de acuerdo con la Iglesia Católica.

**MATRIMONY:** First step is to contact the office to set up an appointment with Fr. Jet.

**BAPTISM:** English baptism classes are held every 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the month at 6:00pm if necessary. Please call the office one week prior to register if you are planning on attending the class. (Classes may be taken before the baby is born.)

### REQUIREMENTS:

- Both Parents and God Parents must attend the Baptism class before the Baptism.
- Godparents are to be (1) fully initiated into the Catholic Church; baptized, received 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation, (2) be at least 16 years old, (3) practicing the faith, and (4) if married - must be in accordance with the Catholic Church.

You will need to come into the office to fill out the proper paperwork and set a date.

**Baptisms are held the 2nd Saturday of every month unless told otherwise**

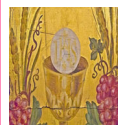


## Quinceañeras
