Vocations Committee Honors Deceased Priests

For Memorial Day, members of St. Cecilia's Vocations Committee, along with some of their family and friends, honored deceased priests and bishops buried at Mt. Calvary Cemetery by placing flowers on their graves.



Placing flowers on priests' graves is something Mt. Calvary has done for years, but with an increase in activities happening Memorial Day weekend, the staff was unable to continue. So they began placing baskets at the ends of the rows instead of flowers at each of the 189 graves.



Fr. Pat McNamee, St. Cecilia's retired parish priest, noticed the change and asked how he could help. The cemetery offered to pay for the flowers if volunteers could be

found to place them. Fr. Pat turned to our Vocations Committee, who readily agreed.
