



# 5<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER, MAY 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2015

Greetings brothers and sisters in Christ! We have many things to be thankful for at this time as a parish. Last weekend eighteen of our students were confirmed at Divine Mercy Catholic Church in Faribault. Bishop Cozzens offered a beautiful homily and there was a full church as we witnessed Bishop Cozzens and Father Clinton confirm around 140 youth from various area parishes. Congratulations to the newly Confirmed who are now fully initiated members of the Catholic Church! "The sacrament of confirmation impresses a character and by it the baptized, continuing on the path of Christian initiation, are enriched by the gift of the Holy Spirit and bound more perfectly to the Church; it strengthens them and obliges them more firmly to be witnesses to Christ by word and deed and to spread and defend the faith" (Canon 879), (*The Essential Catholic Handbook*. Liguori 1997, 159).

A key question for us dear brothers and sisters is at what point did we or will we begin living the grace of our Confirmation. If we do not open ourselves, God will not force Himself upon us. Has the grace of our own Confirmation been dormant? Have we allowed God to work through us to, "...more firmly be witnesses to Christ by word and deed and to spread and defend the faith"? If the grace of this beautiful sacrament is dormant, God will stir it within us as soon as we give our consent! Now is the time!!

This weekend we will celebrate First Communion at Saint Nicholas, another of the three Sacraments of Initiation. This is a test, what are the other two? They are of course... Baptism and Confirmation. There are thirty-five students receiving First Communion this year! Congratulations to you and to your families. Christ will come to you each week in His body, blood, soul, and divinity, to help you, heal you, strengthen you, and journey with you on your pilgrimage to Heaven! I cannot encourage you and your families enough to stay close to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, He will transform your lives as He offers you Himself!

**Carpet update:** We are making the final schedule for the church floor project. This includes taking the pews out, sanding and finishing the wood floors, putting the pews back in, and then replacing all of the carpet in the church with new carpet. The flooring will be done the week of May 18<sup>th</sup> and the week of May 25<sup>th</sup> and the carpet will be installed the week of June 29<sup>th</sup>. During that time we will have daily Mass in the church basement, **not** in the old school building. Please note brothers and sisters that we have heard feedback about the elevator and gathering space planning. The elevator is priority for our parish so that people with disabilities are able to go into the basement for bathroom use and for various parish events and functions. A gathering space is not as high of a priority, but it is important that we continue to plan for the future, especially considering the importance of having a place other than the church body where people can visit after Mass and before funerals. **Right now the only plan of action is to install new carpet and finish the wood floors under the pews.** We will continue to discuss and to seek your feedback before starting any further project regarding an elevator and / or gathering space. God bless!

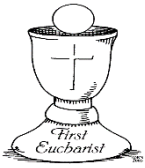
