## NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven (*bow*) and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life who proceeds from the Father and the Son who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe on one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins, and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

## COMMENTARY ON THE CREED

Profession of Faith: The word creed comes from the Latin *credo*, which means “I believe.” Therefore, the Creed unites us with the entire Catholic world. It is the Church’s words summarizing the principal truths of the faith Jesus revealed.

Begotten here has the meaning of “born.” God the Son is born out of the essence of God the Father. Since God is eternal, the Son, being begotten of God, is also eternal.

Consubstantial means Jesus is true God just like God the Father is. They are one substance.

Incarnate means that Jesus became human. Jesus is fully human and fully divine.

His death was not an accident of history nor of forces beyond his control. It was the ransom that would free mankind from the slavery of sin. Jesus, who is both true God and true man, is alone able to offer himself as the perfect sacrifice for our redemption.

The first profession of faith occurs at baptism. Since baptism is conferred “in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit,” the truths of faith expressed in the Creed are divided into three parts corresponding to the three persons of the Holy Trinity. Every Sunday at Mass, as we proclaim the words of the Creed, we renew our baptismal faith.

## CREDO NICENO

Creo en un solo Dios, Padre todopoderoso, Creador del cielo y de la tierra, de todo lo visible y lo invisible. Creo en un solo Señor, Jesucristo, Hijo único de Dios, nacido del Padre antes de todos los siglos: Dios de Dios, Luz de Luz, Dios verdadero de Dios verdadero, engendrado, no creado, consubstantial con el Padre, por quien todo fue hecho; que por nosotros lo hombres, y por nuestra salvación bajó del cielo, (*incline la cabeza*) y por obra del Espíritu Santo se encarnó de María, la Virgen, y se hizo hombre; y por nuestra causa fue crucificado en tiempos de Poncio Pilato; padeció y fue sepultado, y resucitó al tercer día, según las Escrituras, y subió al cielo, y está sentado a la derecha del Padre; y de nuevo vendrá con gloria para juzgar a vivos y muertos, y su reino no tendrá fin. Creo en el Espíritu Santo, Señor y dador de vida, que procede del Padre y del Hijo, que con el Padre y el Hijo recibe una misma adoración y gloria, y que habló por los profetas. Creo en la Iglesia, que es una, santa, católica y apostólica. Confieso que hay un solo bautismo para el perdón de los pecados. Espero la resurrección de los muertos y la vida del mundo futuro. Amén.

## COMENTARIO SOBRE EL CREDO

Profesión de fe: la palabra *credo* proviene del latín *credo*, que significa “yo creo”. Por tanto, el Credo nos une con todo el mundo católico. Son las palabras de la Iglesia que resumen las verdades principales de la fe que Jesús reveló.

Engendrado aquí tiene el significado de “nacido”. Dios el Hijo nace de la esencia de Dios el Padre. Dado que Dios es eterno, el

Hijo, siendo engendrado por Dios, también es eterno.

Consubstantial significa que Jesús es el Dios verdadero al igual que Dios el Padre. Son una substancia.

Encarnado significa que Jesús se hizo humano. Jesús es completamente humano y completamente divino.

Su muerte no fue un accidente de la historia ni de fuerzas fuera de su control. Era el rescate que liberaría a la humanidad de la esclavitud del pecado. Jesús, que es tanto verdadero Dios como verdadero hombre, es el único que puede ofrecerse a sí mismo como el sacrificio perfecto por nuestra redención.

La primera profesión de fe ocurre en el bautismo. Dado que el bautismo se confiere “en el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo”, las verdades de fe expresadas en el Credo se dividen en tres partes correspondientes a las tres personas de la Santísima Trinidad. Todos los domingos en la Misa, al proclamar las palabras del Credo, renovamos nuestra fe bautismal.
