Calendar Dates for the Balance of the School Year

Next week, May 4th through the 8th, school families and parishioners are encouraged to drop off canned goods between 8 and 11 AM at the main doors of the school. These items will be taken to the Lebanon Food Pantry throughout the week.

In order to coordinate the return of school items, textbooks, library books and technology; Remote Learning will conclude on Friday May 15, 2020. The teachers will then coordinate with the school office Report Cards and Permanent Record keeping on May 18 and 19.

We are asking that you please use the following [SignUp Genius](#) to sign up for a time to drop-off and exchange student items. Families are encouraged to sign up today for slots on May 20th, 21st, or 22nd. You will see that there are 10 slots for families per hour; 1 PM through 4 PM and 5 slots from 4 - 4:30 PM on each day.

Please check your homes for any items that may belong back at the school. This includes textbooks, classroom novels, library books, manipulative sets on loan from the teacher, as well as technology signed out for remote learning and the charger for that device.

Report cards for the Fourth Quarter will be emailed to the email address on record after Memorial Day.

Grading and Promotion Policy

As anticipated, the Catholic Schools Office released a policy statement on grading, promotion scores, etc. for the conclusion of the 2019-2020 school year earlier this week.

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Grading and grade reporting for the Fourth Quarter card and permanent record card will take into consideration the variables and challenges of remote learning. Attendance will be recorded at 100% for the fourth quarter.

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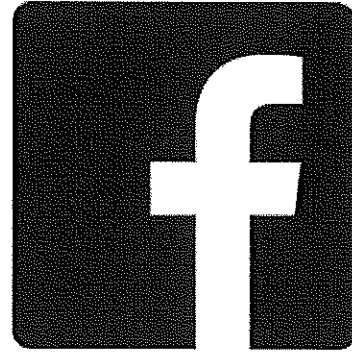

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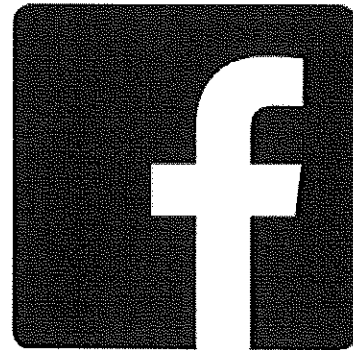

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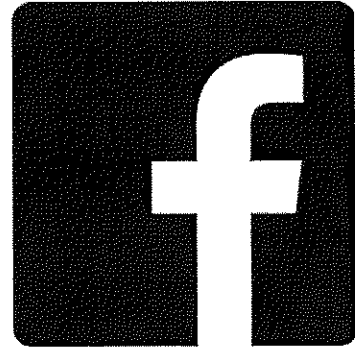

Iowa Testing Scores

Wouldn't you know, that once we make an announcement, there is an adjustment! In this case it is for the better. We have been provided with the aggregate results, by class room, for the Iowa Test of Basic Skills. Once the student reports are made available, these will be distributed to each household in a timely manner. However, we were able to review the scores presented to us at this point in time and in order to be consistent with the past, they are presented as Grade Equivalent Scores. For example, the 7th grade achievement in Reading 2020 was comparable to a Senior mid years performance. Please note that the current grades 2019 and 2020 score is identified, except for Third Grade as they did not have a comparable 2019 score with the CogAt. Congratulations are in order for the students and their hard work this school year!

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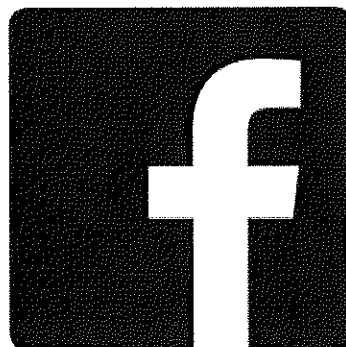

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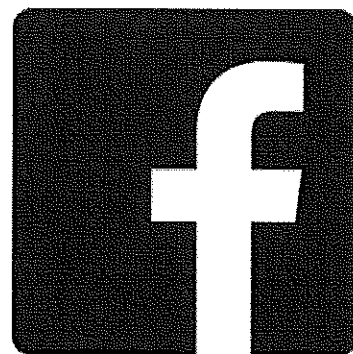

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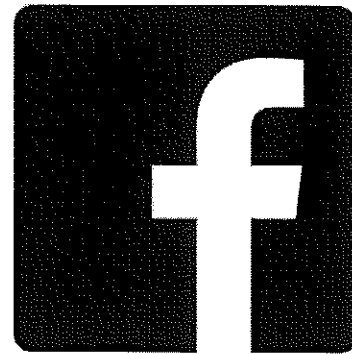
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
