On November 10th, Bishop Edward J. Burns issued a decree stating that the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass will be lifted on November 28th, the first Sunday of Advent. This decree will restore the obligation for Catholics of the Diocese of Dallas to once again attend Mass in person on Sundays and other Holy Days of Obligation.
