

# Saint Report Outline

## Due February 3, 2021

In choosing your Confirmation Saint name, it is important to remember that this is possibly the only time you will choose a name for *yourself!* So do a little searching and find a name that suits you. This Saint could have been born or canonized on your birthday or another special day, patron of something you enjoy (music, sports, art, hobbies, etc), patron of a family name, your nationality, or maybe just seems to have the same type of personality as you do.

Your Saint name will be used as you are Confirmed.

- **A cover sheet should include:**
  - **your name**
  - **Saint's name**
  - **either a drawn or computer generated picture of the Saint.**
- **Your report should be typed in size 12 Arial font, single spaced, on one full 8-1/2 x 11" white sheet.**
- **You should have enough information to fill at least one page.**
- **Write a short prayer, asking this Saint to pray for you or someone else.**
- **Show your research resources at the end.**

Use the following points as a guide for your report. DO NOT copy and paste but rather, do your research and use your own words:

- Saint's birth name, origin and dates of birth and death
- Why did you choose this Saint for your Confirmation name?
- Give a brief history of this person.
- When do we celebrate his/her Feast Day?
- Why was this person canonized a Saint?
- What sort of obstacles did this person have to overcome in his/her life?
- Is this Saint a Patron of something? Why?
- How can you imitate this Saint as you strive to live a Catholic Christian life in the days and years to come?
- Is there a symbol that represents this Saint? Explain what this symbol means.
