From Pastor's desk: Pentecost Sunday 2018. *Reflection: John 20, 19-23: The risen Christ imparts the Holy*

Spirit. John and Luke are the only Evangelists who address the Pentecost event directly. Luke adopts the fifty-day motif, likely patterning it after the Jewish feast of Shavuot, celebrated fifty days after Passover. John, on the other hand, depicts the sending of the Spirit on the "evening of that first day of the week," namely, the evening of the day of the Resurrection. Jesus gives the disciples a message of peace and mercy. He greets them with the standard Jewish greeting "Shalom" and tells them to show God's mercy in the forgiveness of sins. Jesus literally gives them the Spirit in breathing on the eleven, breath being the fundamental meaning of spirit. Let us be aware of the movement of the Spirit in our lives, the Holy Spirit is within each one of us. Moreover, together we are united in the Spirit, who moves among us, here in this building as well as around the whole world.

God of abundant life, on the first day of the week, you raised Christ, your Son, from the dead. As we celebrate this great feast of the sending of the Holy Spirit again on the first day of the week, may we be inspired by your love, mercy, peace, and unity.

Desde el escritorio del Pastor: Domingo de Pentecostés 2018. *Reflexión: Juan 20, 19 - 23: Cristo resucitado imparte el Espíritu Santo.* Juan y Lucas son los únicos evangelistas que abordan el evento de Pentecostés directamente. Lucas adopta el motivo de los cincuenta días, probablemente lo modela después de la fiesta judía de Shavuot, celebrada cincuenta días después de la Pascua. Juan, por otro lado, representa el envío del Espíritu en la "tarde del primer día de la semana", es decir, la tarde del día de la Resurrección. Jesús da los discípulos un mensaje de paz y misericordia. Él los saluda con el saludo judío estándar "Shalom" y les dice que muestren la misericordia de Dios en el perdón de los pecados. Jesús literalmente les da el Espíritu al respirar en los once, siendo la respiración la fundamental significado del espíritu. Tomemos conciencia del movimiento del Espíritu en nuestras vidas, el Espíritu Santo está dentro de cada uno de nosotros. Además, juntos estamos unidos en el Espíritu, que se mueve entre nosotros, aquí en este edificio, así como en todo el mundo. Dios de la vida abundante, en el primer día de la semana, resucitaste a Cristo, tu Hijo, de entre los muertos. Al celebrar esta gran fiesta del envío del Espíritu Santo nuevamente el primer día de la semana, que podamos ser inspirados por su amor, misericordia, paz y unidad.
