From Pastor's desk: – Twenty – Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018.

Reflection: Mark 10, 2 – 16: Therefore what God has joined together, let no human being separate. To reiterate the Mosaic Law concerning marriage is not to reject couples whose marriages fail. It is to say that in the modern era, many marriages never begin. The couple holds the premise that commitments can always be broken, that lifelong is symbolic, and that one's individual happiness, fulfillment, and freedom are all that matters. Good things rarely happen by accident. Fidelity, struggle, and forgiveness bear the fruit of beauty, love, and happiness if we persevere in our commitments. How appropriate on this Respect Life Sunday. All life, everyone's life, is a gift from God, a gift given out of love by our Creator. Therefore, all life is precious in God's eyes. If all life is precious, all life is worthy of our love. With that attitude and with God remaining in us, we can sing the second half of the Gospel acclamation, and God's love is brought to perfection in us. Let us reflect on how we have or can become co-creators, creating bonds and creating life from the impulse of love.


