From Pastor's desk: Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time 2018.

Reflection: Mark 12, 28-34: Love the Lord your God. Love your neighbor.

Jesus offers us in this Gospel a path to follow in life: love of God and love of neighbor should direct every action. When faced with decisions in life, our first question must be: how does the law of love of God and neighbor influence this situation? The love of God is the supreme commandment. Unfortunately, some allow this fact to relegate charity and justice to second place. It should be clear logically that the love of God is bottom line. A preacher might speak of addressing the needs of the poor; a listener might ask what this has to do with his spiritual life! The comprehensive love expressed by the scribe and affirmed by Jesus should form every good work and every relationship. We reflect on what is truly important in this life. Perhaps the scribe who comes to Jesus and asks: "Which is the first of all the commandments?" is thinking this way. He certainly was after Jesus told him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God". Rooted in God's love, you have learned to love your neighbor as yourself.

Infinite Love, your incomprehensible love brought us to life and sustains us. May we never take this love for granted, but respond appropriately with all our heart, soul, mind and strength.

Reflexión: Marcos 12, 28-34: Ama al Señor tu Dios. Ama a tu prójimo. Jesús nos ofrece en este Evangelio un camino a seguir en la vida: El amor a Dios y el amor al prójimo deben dirigir cada acción. Cuando nos enfrentamos con decisiones en la vida, nuestra primera pregunta debe ser: ¿Cómo influye la ley del amor a Dios y al prójimo a esta situación? El amor a Dios es el mandamiento supremo. Desafortunadamente, algunos permiten que este hecho relegue la caridad y la justicia al segundo lugar. Debe quedar claro lógicamente que el amor de Dios es primordial. Un predicador puede hablar sobre atender las necesidades de los pobres; Un oyente puede preguntar ¡qué tiene esto que ver con la vida espiritual! El amor comprensivo expresado por el escriba y afirmado por Jesús debe formar toda buena obra y cada relación. Reflexionamos sobre lo que es verdaderamente importante en esta vida. Quizás el escriba que viene a Jesús y pregunta: ¿Cuál es el primero de todos los mandamientos? está pensando de esta manera. Ciertamente lo estuvo después de que Jesús le dijo: "No estás lejos del reino de Dios". Arraigado en el amor de Dios, has aprendido a amar a tu prójimo como a ti mismo.

Amor infinito, tu amor incomprensible nos trajo a la vida y nos sostiene. Que nunca demos por hecho este amor, sino que respondamos adecuadamente con todo nuestro corazón, alma, mente y fuerzas.
