From Pastor's Desk: Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph.

Reflection: Luke 2, 41 – 52: Mary and Joseph find Jesus teaching in the temple.

In the Gospel, we learn that the Holy Family went to Jerusalem for Passover. They journeyed in a caravan, because it was the safest way to travel through the countryside. On their way home, when Mary and Joseph realize that their son was not with the caravan, they return to Jerusalem in a panic, only to find him teaching the elders in the Temple. Making the situation even more bizarre, Jesus tells them, "Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?" In the ancient world and in some cultures today, childhood stories are regarded as predictors of the child's destiny. Just as Jesus, Mary, and Joseph worshipped God together with their faith community, we too, gather in God's house with one another as the family of God. Today is an opportunity to reflect on the blessed gift of worshipping together as one family in faith. The example of the Holy Family of Nazareth shows us that praying together with others strengthens us to face daily challenges.

O God, you provided the Holy Family with strength to face adversity, grant our families the fortitude to resolve problems and become a witness of your love. Help all in need to know your kindness and compassion.

Reflexión: Lucas 2, 41-52: María y José encuentran a Jesús enseñando en el templo.

En el Evangelio, nos enteramos de que la Sagrada Familia fue a Jerusalén para la Pascua. Viajaron en una caravana, porque era la manera más segura de viajar por el campo. En su camino a casa, cuando María y José se dieron cuenta de que su hijo no estaba con la caravana, regresaron a Jerusalén en pánico, sólo para encontrarlo enseñando a los ancianos en el templo. Haciendo la situación aún más extraña, Jesús les dice, "¿No sabéis que debo estar en casa de mi padre?" En el mundo antiguo y en algunas culturas de hoy, dichos de la infancia son considerados predictores del destino del niño. Igual que Jesús, María y José adoraban a Dios junto con su comunidad de fe, también nosotros, nos reunimos en la casa de Dios unos con otros como la familia de Dios. Hoy es una oportunidad para reflexionar sobre el don bendito de adorar juntos como una familia en la fe. El ejemplo de la Sagrada Familia de Nazaret nos muestra que el orar juntos nos fortalece para hacer frente a los desafíos de cada día.

Oh Dios, tu que le diste a la Sagrada Familia fortaleza para enfrenar la adversidad, otorga a nuestras familias la fortaleza para resolver problemas y convertirse en testigos de tu amor. Ayuda a todos los que estén en necesidad a conocer tu bondad y compasión.
