From Pastor's Desk: FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reflection: Luke 5, 1 – 11: They left everything, even their nets, and followed Jesus.

We are called to be disciples of Jesus. It is not enough just to believe; we are asked to take up our crosses and follow him. We are challenged to make sacrifices. We are challenged to live out our faith. We are challenged to be face of Jesus to those whom we meet. Simon did not know what he was getting into when he let Jesus into his boat and then lowered his nets at one command. Simon's hope for a catch was answered beyond all measure and followed with an invitation to another life. Through our Baptism, we have been called to discipleship. That sometimes means leaving our comfort Zones and old patterns to take on a new life in the Lord.

Loving God, you raise up those who are lowly and lost. May all see your loving grace and plan guiding them to your kingdom, where you live and reign with our Lord Jesus Christ.
