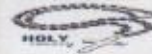

### REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

1. Child Birth Certificate 2. \$15 fee 3. Must be registered member of Holy family or have permission from their parish 4. Godparent(s) must be over age 16, have the sacraments of baptism, communion & confirmation. Must be single or have marriage certificate 5. Parents and Godparents must attend Baptismal classes after completing paperwork or show proof that they have attended classes within the past 3 years. (Contact Office first)

**From Pastor's Desk: SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

*Reflection: Lucas 6, 17, 20 -26: The Beatitudes.*

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus showed his union with those who are poor, who are hungry, and who are weak. In saying that they are "blessed," he pointed them toward heaven. Too often we think of the here and now. It is helpful to be reminded that we long and hope for heaven. Our time on earth, during which we may be hated for doing what is right, is just a station along the way. We may have sorrows now, but we can look forward to blessings in heaven. As we listen to today's Gospel. Let us ponder which ones most closely apply to our lives. Jesus reassures those who are suffering while warning those who are prospering. It is sobering. Our prayer and hope is that you will be counted among those whom God calls "blessed."

Loving God, we crave for your hand to lead us to our heavenly home. May we know that our present life is only a glimpse of the beautiful reality that awaits us with our ancestors in faith. Help us to spread your mercy and compassion among those we encounter in our lives.
