**From Pastor's Desk:** Second Sunday of Easter 2019.

*Reflection: John 20, 19-31: How blessed are those who have not seen but have believed.*

Each year on this Second Sunday of Easter we are faced with confronting our sense of doubt and faith. Like Thomas, we are called to examine the mysteries of life, especially the mystery of what it means to have life in Christ. We reach out again from our present age to recall that Christ is always wishing us peace, always breathing this gift upon us. This Spirit renews us to strengthen our faith and helps us go forward to profess "My Lord and my God". Again and again, Jesus says, "Peace be with you." This gift of peace is connected with the power of the Holy Spirit and the mandate that God's mercy be shared with others: share the gift of peace with someone who is expressing doubt about God's love and mercy by offering your presence and words of reassurance. This Gospel calls us all to open our eyes and experience the many ways that God's mercy and love touch us in our daily lives.

*God of tenderness and mercy, you call us to share our belief in you and minister to those in need of your care.*

*Guide our efforts of evangelization so that we may bring others to know of your love for them.*

Como Tomás, estamos llamados a examinar los misterios de la vida, especialmente el misterio de lo que significa tener vida en Cristo. Nos extendemos nuevamente desde nuestra era presente para recordar que Cristo siempre nos está deseando paz, Siempre respirando este regalo sobre nosotros. Este Espíritu nos renueva para fortalecer nuestra fe y nos ayuda a seguir adelante para profesar "Mi Señor y mi Dios". Una y otra vez, Jesús dice: "La paz esté con ustedes". Este don de paz está con el poder del Espíritu Santo y el mandato de que la misericordia de Dios se comparta con los demás: comparta el don de la paz con alguien que esté expresando dudas sobre el amor y la misericordia de Dios ofreciendo su presencia y palabras de tranquilidad. Este Evangelio nos llama a todos a abrir los ojos y experimentar las muchas maneras en que la misericordia y el amor de Dios nos afectan en nuestra vida diaria.
