From Pastor's Desk: Third Sunday of Easter 2019

Reflection: John 21, 1 – 19: The risen Christ welcomes his own at the seashore.

In today's Gospel, the disciples seem not to know what to do with themselves without Jesus, until Peter announces that he is going fishing back to his old way of life, and the others join in. Suddenly the Risen Lord appears on the shore, waiting to share breakfast with them. The bread and fish suggest that the meal has Eucharistic overtones. After breakfast, Jesus gives Peter a mission and foreshadows the manner in which he would die, all for spreading the Good News. Jesus is always on the lips and in the minds of the Apostles. As you are listening to today's readings, think about how you visualize Jesus. In the span of a few weeks we have heard Simon Peter deny that he even knew Jesus, and today we hear his great confession of love for the very man he betrayed. The Lord Jesus will always call you back to him, even after moments of betrayal. Take these words to heart as you go forth to reflect on today's scriptures.

Gentle shepherd and guide, inspire us to true service with loving hearts and minds focusing on the ever increasing needs of your kingdom. May we be open to your Son and his vision and witness of faithful discipleship.

Reflexión: Juan 21, 1 – 19: El Cristo resucitado da la bienvenida a los suyos en la orilla del mar.

En el Evangelio de hoy, los discípulos parecen no saber qué hacer sin Jesús, hasta que Pedro anuncia que va de pesca de manera usual, y los otros se unen a él. El Señor resucitado aparece repentinamente a la orilla del mar, esperando compartir el desayuno con ellos. El pan y los pescados sugieren que la comida tiene connotaciones eucarísticas. Después del desayuno, Jesús da una misión de Pedro y prefigura la manera en que él va a morir, todo por enseñar la buena nueva. Jesús está siempre en los labios y en la mente de los apóstoles. Cuando estén escuchando las lecturas de hoy, piensen en cómo ustedes visualizan a Jesús. En el lapso de unas pocas semanas hemos escuchado a Simón Pedro negar que incluso conociera a Jesús, y hoy escuchamos su gran confesión de amor por el mismo hombre a quien traicionó. El Señor Jesús siempre te llamará a él, incluso después de momentos de traición. Toma estas palabras en tu corazón al reflexionar sobre las lecturas de hoy.

Tierno pastor y guía, inspíranos al verdadero servicio con corazón y mente amorosos centrados siempre en las necesidades de tu reino que crecen cada vez más. Que estemos abiertos a tu hijo y su visión y testimonio del discipulado fiel.
