From Pastor's Desk: Fourth Sunday of Easter 2019

Reflection: John 10, 27 – 30: *No one can harm one of Jesus' lambs.*

The verbs in this short Gospel highlight key aspects of our faith life. Jesus reminds us to "hear" and to "follow" and tells us that we will not be taken from the Father. The Shepherd is always giving to those who listen. Our lives are to reflect Christ's and we are to be open to shepherding others. In our discipleship, we can let those we encounter know of the gift of eternal life that we are offered. At the same time, we have a role as sheep that always listen and pay attention to the Good Shepherd. After all, the Good Shepherd, as Jesus is portrayed in today's Gospel, gathers all to himself. Indeed, all of us "are his people, the sheep of his flock". How appropriate that this wonderful image is presented on Mother's Day. Today we honor all types of mothers who have loved us, protected us, helped us, held us and who have treated us with the tender loving care of the Good Shepherd. Let us give thanks today for all our mothers, living and deceased.

Gentle Shepherd and guide, help us to be open to your word and renew our efforts to lead all to your pasture.

Bless our mothers, who were created in your pastoral image. May all know your ways and guide others to the promise that is won in the unity of the Son and Spirit, one God forever and ever.
