From Pastor's Desk: Sixth Sunday of Easter 2019

Reflection; John 14:23-29: *Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit to guide his followers.*

In today's Gospel, Jesus promises his disciples that God will continue to dwell with them and with all who love him. This Gospel also reminds us that God will make a place within those who love Jesus. Not only will God dwell within them but so will the peace that Christ leaves with them. How often do we hear words of peace? Enough to believe, live and feel them? What would it be like for people to hear daily "the peace of the Lord be with you"? What reaction might that draw when said to others? We are called to continue to breathe peace so that people will not be afraid, but will trust and believe.
