From Pastor's Desk: Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

Reflection: Luke 9: 12 – 17: The feeding of the multitudes.

Jesus looked lovingly on the crowd and provided for them. Through the Eucharist, God continues to offer food for the journey. At Mass, we offer our lives up and Christ nourishes us at the table of the Lord. We then are dismissed to "go and announce the Gospel," making our lives nourishment for others. At times we may feel we are living in a deserted place and barren. But we can always come to the Eucharist to eat and be satisfied. We trust that God's love is bountiful, and we give that love to others. Summer has begun, with warm temperatures and long sunny days; this season brings intense growth to many of the fruits and vegetables we eat. Here and now, though, we focus on a different kind of food, the Eucharist. Bread and wine are offered by God's people, and through the priest, are blessed by God, becoming the Body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Sharing this meal today, in remembrance of the Last Supper, we find our true sustenance. *Lord God, you gave us your Son so that we may feed on the Eucharist, the everlasting memorial of love and thanksgiving. May we always share your gifts as we seek to renew the face of the earth to bring about your reign.*

Del escritorio del Pastor: Solemnidad del Cuerpo y La Sangre de Cristo

Reflexión: Lucas 9: 12-17: La alimentación de las multitudes.

Jesús miraba amorosamente a la muchedumbre y proveía por ellos. A través de la Eucaristía, Dios sigue ofreciendo comida para el viaje. En la Misa, ofrecemos nuestras vidas y Cristo nos alimenta en la mesa del Señor. Entonces somos despedidos a que vayamos a "ir y anunciar el Evangelio," para que nuestras vidas sean alimento para otros. A veces podemos sentir que estamos viviendo en un lugar desolado y árido. Pero siempre podemos venir a la Eucaristía para comer y satisfacernos. Confiamos en que el amor de Dios es abundante, y damos ese amor a otros. Ha comenzado el verano, con temperaturas cálidas y días de mucho sol; esta temporada trae crecimiento intenso a muchas de las frutas y verduras que comemos. Aquí y ahora, sin embargo, nos centramos en un tipo diferente de alimento, la Eucaristía. El Pan y el Vino se ofrecen por el pueblo de Dios y por el sacerdote, son bendecidos por Dios, convirtiéndose en el Cuerpo y La Sangre de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Compartiendo esta cena hoy, en recordatorio de la última cena, encontramos nuestro verdadero sustento.

Señor, tu nos diste a tu hijo para que nos alimentemos de la Eucaristía, el memorial eterno de amor y agradecimiento. Que siempre compartamos tus regalos al intentar renovar la faz de la tierra y traer acabo tu reino.
