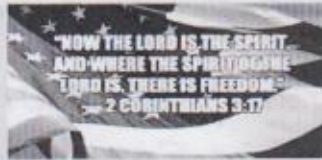

From Pastor's Desk: Thirteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time 2019.

Reflection: Luke 9, 51 – 62: Jesus expects us to leave everything to follow him.

"Follow me," Jesus says to a potential disciple he encounters on his journey to Jerusalem. As Jesus calls people, we hear legitimate reasons for putting off the call to follow. Jesus replies to other potential disciples who ask about burying the dead or bidding farewell to loved ones. What keeps you from following Christ? Are there things that you can leave behind so that you may freely follow Christ Jesus? If anger or past hurts are holding you back, it may be time to say goodbye to them and move on. Today Jesus may be urging you not to look back. Jesus teaches his disciples, the crowds and all of us how God wants us to live our lives. Today we learn that discipleship demands a total commitment. Listening to today's readings, we have the opportunity to think of what we are willing to leave behind on our journey toward the kingdom of God.

Ever-faithful God, you lead us along our journey. Renew our minds and hearts so that we may follow you more closely.

Grant us the courage to release past hurts and take on our call as disciples to bring your Good News to all we meet.

Jesús enseña a sus discípulos, a la muchedumbre y a todos nosotros cómo Dios quiere que vivamos nuestras vidas. Hoy nos enteramos que el discipulado exige un compromiso total. Al escuchar las lecturas de hoy, tenemos la oportunidad de pensar en lo que estamos dispuestos a dejar atrás en nuestro camino hacia el Reino de Dios.
