From Pastor's Desk: Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Reflection: *Luke 10: 25 – 37: Even the stranger is to be loved as a neighbor.*

Through the parable of the Good Samaritan, Jesus teaches us how we should treat each other. The Good Samaritan shows that obeying the greatest commandment leads one to exercise compassion and mercy. For centuries, societies have tried to answer the question "who is my neighbor? Today's reading depicts a person who offers mercy to a stranger in answer to this question. As a Christian, our response to another should be to provide mercy. That is especially true when the person cannot reciprocate. Today's Gospel account portrays mercy well since it personifies not only a good deed but how another is acknowledged and accorded dignity. Whom do you encounter who would be grateful for your recognition?



Merciful God, you teach us compassion and care for all your people. Help us to be open to console those burdened and in strife so that all may come to know your love.

Reflexión: *Lucas 10: 25 – 37: Incluso el desconocido debe ser amado como prójimo.*

A través de la parábola del Buen Samaritano, Jesús nos enseña cómo nos debemos tratar los unos a los otros. El Buen Samaritano muestra que obedeciendo el mandamiento más grande nos lleva a ejercer la compasión y la misericordia. Durante siglos, las sociedades han tratado de responder a la pregunta ¿quién es mi prójimo? La lectura de hoy representa a una persona que ofrece misericordia a un extranjero en respuesta a esta pregunta. Como Cristianos, nuestra respuesta a los demás debe ser la de ofrecer misericordia. Eso es especialmente cierto cuando la persona no puede corresponder. El evangelio enseña muy bien lo que es la misericordia, puesto que encarna no sólo una buena acción sino que también muestra como este es reconocido y otorgado dignidad. ¿Quién estaría agradecido de recibir tu reconocimiento?

Dios misericordioso, enséñanos compasión y cuidado para toda tu gente. Ayúdanos a estar abiertos a consolar a los agobiados para que todos puedan llegar a conocer tu amor.
