**From Pastor's Desk:** Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

**Reflection: Luke 10, 38 – 42:** Martha and Mary received Jesus as a guest.

Hospitality is at the heart of today's Gospel as Jesus visits the home of Martha and Mary. Jesus uses this visit to teach something deeper about hospitality. While Mary sits at Jesus's feet, Martha complains to Jesus because Mary is not doing anything to help her. Instead of agreeing with Martha, Jesus scolds her in a kindly way: "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things." He goes to say that "Mary has chosen the better part." While not rejecting Martha's cooking, Jesus wants to remind Martha, and through her us, that service must also be connected to listening. Service that does not embrace listening to Jesus' word misses the heart of everything. That is why Jesus says that Mary has chosen "the good portion." Mary has in fact chosen the best part of the meal. Christianity requires service, but the Word of the Lord needs to be heard first. We hear the Lord speak to Martha and Mary, assuring them of the importance of listening and learning. We hear the Lord speak, as we do each Sunday, in the breaking of the bread. So Let us listen and hear what the Lord says to us.

*Loving God, you offer hospitality to those who seek you. Grant always that we, your children, may choose to be in your presence and listen to your Word and guidance.*

**Del escritorio del Pastor:** Decimosexto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

**Reflexión: Lucas 10, 38 – 42:** Marta y María recibieron a Jesús como huésped.

La hospitalidad está al corazón del Evangelio de hoy cuando Jesús visita a la casa de Marta y María. Jesús utiliza esta visita para enseñar algo más profundo acerca de la hospitalidad. Mientras María se sienta a los pies de Jesús, Marta se queja a Jesús porque María no está haciendo nada para ayudarla. En lugar de estar de acuerdo con Marta, Jesús le reprende de una manera bondadosa: "Marta, Marta, estás inquieta y preocupada por muchas cosas." Él continúa diciendo que "María ha escogido la mejor parte". Aunque no rechaza la comida de Marta, Jesús quiere recordarle a Martha y a través de ella a nosotros, que el servicio debe conectarse con el escuchar. El servicio que no se conecta con el escuchar la palabra de Jesús pierde el corazón de todo. Es por eso que Jesús dice que María ha escogido "la mejor parte". De hecho, María sí ha escogido la mejor parte de la comida. El Cristianismo exige el servicio, pero la palabra del Señor tiene que escucharse primero. Escuchamos al Señor hablar con Marta y María, asegurándoles la importancia de escuchar y aprender. Escuchamos al Señor hablar, como hacemos cada domingo en la fracción del pan. Así que hay que escuchar y oír lo que el Señor nos dice.
