From Pastor's Desk: Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2019

Reflection: Luke 12: 13 – 21: Avoid greed in all its forms.

Our consumer culture thrives on possessions and accumulating more and more things. It is no wonder we become obsessed with stuff. We are invited to form a different sort of relationship with possessions. This relationship would have regard for what matters in life. As many have found, giving away things not only lightens the burden on the earth but also helps us achieve our ultimate happiness found in God alone. Examine whether your treasure is in your possessions. "The things you have prepared, to whom will they belong?" The lesson of the parable is that we should place our security in our relationship with God rather than on earthly wealth. One of the most challenging points of conversion for those seeking a deeper relationship with the Lord has to do with how we handle material wealth.

Loving God, you have taught us that our heart will be where our treasure is. Help us to aim for what the kingdom offers. May we share our riches with our brothers and sisters, always seeking their welfare.

Reflexión: Lucas 12: 13 – 21: Evite la codicia en todas sus formas.

Estamos invitados a formar un tipo de relación diferente con las posesiones. Esta relación tomaría en cuenta lo que realmente importa en la vida. Como muchos han visto, regalando cosas no sólo aligera la carga sobre la tierra pero también nos ayuda a alcanzar nuestra felicidad suprema que solo se encuentra en Dios. Examiné si su tesoro está en sus posesiones. "Las cosas que ha preparado, a quien le pertenecerán?" La lección de la parábola es que debemos poner nuestra seguridad en nuestra relación con Dios, en lugar de las riquezas terrenales. Uno de los puntos más difíciles de la conversión para aquellos que buscan una relación más profunda con el Señor tiene que ver con la manera en que manejamos las riquezas materiales.
