From Pastor's Desk: – Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time 2019.

Reflection: Luke 13, 22 – 30: The doorway into the kingdom is narrow.

"I do not know where you are from." Jesus knows those who have lived as he has commanded. Calling ourselves Christians and abiding minimally to the faith does not merit a person the kingdom of God. Jesus tells his followers to enter by the narrow gate. Have you conformed your life to Christ's? Have you done the hard work of getting to know him by bringing him into your heart? Jesus tells us in today's Gospel that the gate to eternal life is narrow and many will not get through. However, Jesus speaks of people from the ends of the earth being welcomed into the presence of the Lord. We would do well to remember what God asks of us and then follow the advice of Hebrews and accept discipline. So let us exercise the discipline to listen to the Word of God and take it to heart.

Lord God, you call us this Lord's Day to renew our covenant with you and continue to build the kingdom of love and justice. Guide our efforts at evangelization so that we may bring others to the banquet feast you prepare for us.

Reflexión: Lucas 13:22-30- La puerta de entrada al reino es estrecha. "No sé de dónde eres". Jesús conoce a aquellos que han vivido como él ha mandado nosotros mismos cristianos y permanecer mínimamente en la fe no merece a una persona el reino de Dios. Jesús les dice a sus seguidores que entren por la puerta angosta. ¿Has conformado tu vida a la de Cristo? ¿Has hecho el arduo trabajo de conocerlo llevándolo a tu corazón? Jesús nos dice en Evangelio de hoy de que la puerta a la vida eterna es estrecha y muchos no la atravesarán. Sin embargo, Jesús habla de personas de los confines de la tierra que son bienvenidas a la presencia del Señor. Lo haríamos haz bien en recordar lo que Dios nos pide y luego sigue el consejo de Hebreos y acepta disciplina. Así que ejercitemos la disciplina para escuchar la Palabra de Dios y tomarla en serio.

Señor Dios, nos llamas este Día del Señor para renovar nuestro pacto contigo y continuar construyendo el reino de amor y justicia. Guíe nuestros esfuerzos de evangelización para que podamos traer a otros al banquete que usted nos prepara.
