From Pastor's Desk: Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time 2019.

Reflection: Luke 14, 25-33: Do you want to be a disciple? Renounce everything else, with no reservations, no regrets.



Today's reading invites us to reflect on what possesses us and what we need to leave behind to love the Lord fully. What do you value in your life? Do you value any of those things or people more than you value the Lord? A scene from the 1986 movie *The Mission* vividly portrays the need to cut out what holds us back from climbing the mountain of the Lord. We do not go to heaven with what weighs us down. What is the Lord inviting you to let go during this day? A new school year has just begun for many of us. What an appropriate time to act as a student eager to learn what it takes to follow the Lord. As we listen and reflect on God's Word today, let us find hope in our mission as Christ's twenty-first-century disciples.

O Lord, you teach us your ways and truth. Grant that we may desire to deepen our faith. May we give honor to you and not the things of this earth. Keep us faithful to your path of justice and righteousness so that all may be provided hope and live in your goodness.
