**From Pastor's Desk:** From Pastor's Desk: Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

*Reflection: Luke 17:11-19* Ten lepers show faith in obeying the Lord but in thankfulness one goes a step further - straight into the kingdom of God. When he realized that he had been healed, the Samaritan returned, praised God, dropped to the ground, and thanked Jesus. Each Sunday, we return to our parishes to give praise and worship to God as we celebrate the Eucharist. We gather not only to praise God but to offer our sacrifice and give thanks for all God has provided. The word "Eucharist" means thanksgiving. We not only receive the sacrament but leave the Mass to live a Eucharistic life, or a life of thanksgiving to God. May we keep in mind daily how God has blessed us and give a return of prayers of thanksgiving. As we listen to today's Gospel, let us consider how God has blessed us, so we can sincerely respond, "Thanks be to God." Gracious God of our ancestors, you lead your people and guide them to be people of great thanks and praise. Support us as we renew our efforts to help others to see your glory and blessed world you have created.

*Reflexión: Lucas 17:11-19* Diez leprosos muestran fe en obedecer al Señor, pero en agradecimiento uno va un paso más allá: directamente al reino de Dios. Cuando se dio cuenta de que había sido sanado, el samaritano regresó, alabó a Dios, cayó a la tierra, y agradecido a Jesús. Cada volvemos a nuestras parroquias para dar alabanza y adoración a Dios al celebrar la Eucaristía. Nos reunimos no sólo para alabar a Dios, sino para nuestro sacrificio y dar gracias por todo lo que Dios ha proporcionado. La palabra "Eucaristía" significa acción de gracias. No sólo recibimos la Santa Cena, sino que dejamos la Misa para vivir una vida eucarística, o una vida de acción de gracias a Dios. Que todos los días tengamos presente cómo Dios nos ha bendecido y devolvamos las oraciones de acción de gracias. A medida que escuchen el Evangelio de hoy, consideremos cómo Dios nos ha bendecido, para que podamos responder sinceramente: "Gracias a Dios". Dios misericordioso de nuestros antepasados, guíais a tu pueblo y los guías para que sean personas de gran agradecimiento y alabanza.
