**From Pastor's Desk:** Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2019.

Reflection: Luke 18, 9 – 14: "O God, be merciful to me a sinner."

How do we sound when we pray? A spiritual director shared with me that she had asked people to record themselves in their prayer. She maintained that the spiritual life could be deepened through listening to one's prayer. For example, if a person found that in prayer, the world was blamed for problems, he or she might move from blame to gratitude and humility. Praying "Be merciful to me a sinner." The tax collector stood before God with humility. He knew his place before God. Let us examine our consciences and recognize our need for God's mercy. Jesus tells us look inside ourselves and recognize our needfulness, our humanness, our poverty. What prayer do we need to make to God today? Merciful God, you are always awaiting us. Help all in need of your care to know of your deep love and concern so that we may each deepen our relationship with you and grow in holiness and wisdom.

Reflexión: Lucas 18, 9 – 14: "Oh Dios, sé misericordioso conmigo un pecador."

¿Cómo sonamos cuando oramos? Un director espiritual compartió conmigo que había pedido a la gente que se registrara en su oración. Sostuvo que la vida espiritual podía profundizarse al escuchar la oración. Por ejemplo, si un persona encontró que en la oración, el mundo era culpado por problemas, él o ella podría pasar de la culpa a la gratitud y la humildad. Orando "sé misericordioso conmigo un pecador." El recaudador de impuestos se presentó ante Dios con humildad. Él conocía su lugar ante Dios. Examinemos nuestras conciencias y reconozcamos nuestra necesidad de misericordia de Dios. Jesús nos dice que miremos dentro de nosotros mismos y reconozcamos nuestra necesidad, nuestra humanidad, nuestra pobreza. ¿Qué oración debemos hacer a Dios hoy? Dios misericordioso, siempre nos estás esperando. Ayude a todos los que necesitan su cuidado a saber de su profundo amor y preocupación para que cada uno profundice nuestra relación con usted es y crezca en santidad y sabiduría.
