**From Pastor's Desk: Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time 2019.**

*Reflection: Luke 19, 1-10: Jesus came to seek and to save what was lost.*

One can imagine the joy of Zacchaeus, when Jesus sees him. But the story does not end with this tax collector's rejoicing. The next verses tell of the change of heart that Zacchaeus experienced. Not only did he say he would give half his possessions to the poor but he would repay fourfold anyone he had extorted. Upon encountering Jesus, Zacchaeus was able to detach from his possessions. In the Word and Eucharist we meet Christ. Have those encounters prompted you to detach from any possessions or change in any way? Let us pray today for the eyes of Zacchaeus, eager to see Jesus wherever he can be found. Be inspired by today's Gospel. May the story of Zacchaeus reach deep into our hearts. Whenever you feel lost on your journey of conversion, be assured of God's abundant mercy, which reaches out to seek and to save the lost.

God, our loving Father, you bring us to newness of life. Guide along the paths of holiness your people searching for meaning, so that they may come to rejoice in their ever deeper relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ your Son.

*Reflexión: Lucas 19, 1-10: Jesús vino a buscar y salvar lo que se había perdido*

Uno puede imaginar la alegría de Zaqueo, cuando Jesús lo ve. Pero la historia no termina con este impuesto regocijo de coleccionista. Los siguientes versículos hablan del cambio de corazón que experimentó Zaqueo. No sólo lo hizo decir que daría la mitad de sus posesiones a los pobres, pero pagaría cuatro veces a cualquiera que hubiera extorsionado. Al encontrarse con Jesús, Zaqueo pudo desprenderse de sus posesiones. En la Palabra y la Eucaristía nos encontramos Cristo. ¿Esos encuentros te han llevado a desprenderte de alguna posición o cambio de alguna manera? Oremos hoy por los ojos de Zaqueo, ansiosos por ver a Jesús dondequiera que sea encontrado. Inspírese en la Evangelio. Que la historia de Zaqueo llegue a lo más profundo de nuestros corazones. Cuando os sintáis perdidos en vuestro camino de conversión, tened la seguridad de la abundante misericordia de Dios, que tiende la mano para buscar y salvar a los perdidos. Dios, nuestro Padre amoroso, nos llevas a la novedad de la vida. Guía por los caminos de la santidad tu pueblo busca significado, para que puedan regocijarse en su relación cada vez más profunda con nuestro Señor Jesucristo tu Hijo.
