From Pastor's Desk: Thirty- Second Sunday in Ordinary Time 2019.

Reflection: Luke 20:27-38 In God there is no death.

As the liturgical year nears its end, the readings reflect more on the life to come. In answering the query, Jesus points out that our earthly attachments are not our focus in heaven. When we reach the next life, nothing will be as it is in this world, where people live and die and marry and are given in marriage. There, the focus will be on God. Jesus assures his questioners that to God, even those who have died are alive. We are a people filled with hope, because we believe that death is not the end. As we celebrate Mass today, let our hope in eternal life comfort us as we recall our beloved dead.

O God, you are always faithful to us. Guide our ways and teach us to recognize that the things of this world are passing and that you are our true homeland, where all rest in your love and goodness.
