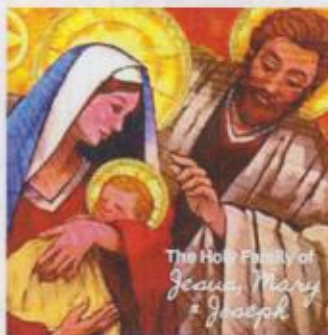

From Pastor's Desk: Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph 2019.

Reflection: Matthew 2, 13 - 15, 19 - 23: Out of Egypt I called my son.

One might think that the family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph is too remote, too special, too holy to be an effective model for our families, they enjoyed times of great joy but also suffered through terrible hardships. The delight of a newborn baby was accompanied by the fear that led them to flee to foreign land. Dreams, warnings, travel and movement dominate Mathew's account of the infancy narrative. Sadly, the horrific tragedy of infanticide and destruction still takes place in the world. Joseph was attentive to the signs and followed God's paths for his family. We also have a role in allowing God's ways to be fulfilled. May we be alert to ways that life is crushed in our society. So let us pray that the faith and love shown by the Holy Family may sustain us through both our joys and struggles.

O God, you provided the Holy Family with strength to face adversity. Grant our families the fortitude to resolve problems and become a witness of our love. Help all in need to know your kindness and compassion.
