From Pastor's Desk: Second Sunday in Ordinary Time 2020.

Reflection: John 1, 29 – 34 Behold, the Lamb of God

John the Baptist is the herald of the One who will bring good news. John's announcement sets the stage for the ministry of Jesus as he takes up his mission of preaching forgiveness and calling his disciples to follow in his footsteps. This too is our mission: to seek the forgiveness of the Lord and to be willing to forgive with the same spirit as he did. The exclamation of John appears in our celebration of Mass as we prepare for communion: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world." We hear these words proclaimed again each Sunday when we are invited to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. We are blessed to be called to this Eucharist meal.

Loving and provident God, you sent your Son into our midst to bring the Good News of the Kingdom and to instill in us a burning desire to follow him as faithful disciples. Grant that we may be sincere in our hearts and unfailing in our baptismal commitments.
