**From Pastor's Desk: Third Sunday in Ordinary Time 2020.**

*Reflection: Matthew 4, 12 – 23: Andrew and Peter abandon their nets to follow the Lord.*

Jesus' call of the first disciples marks a significant point in his mission. Matthew presents this incident as an indication that Jesus' mission will require others to help him spread the Good News of the Kingdom. What is even more astounding is that these ordinary men leave their occupation and their equipment and follow Jesus. The response of Peter and the others is striking. Matthew would have us believe that Jesus' mission is so attractive that it cannot be ignored. How willing are we to do the same? What would it cost us to follow the Lord with such abandon? Jesus began his mission by fulfilling the words of the great prophet Isaiah. Today we contemplate the mission we are called to and pray that we can fulfill the plan God has for all of us. So let us hold one another in the light and peace of Christ. We rejoice that the Lord has called you by name, just as the first Apostles: Peter, Andrew, James and John.

In every age, O God, you have called men and women to follow the path of your Son, Jesus Christ. Give us the courage to follow his example in all things and to serve others without prejudice or expectation.

**Desde el escritorio del pastor: Tercer domingo en el tiempo ordinario 2020.**

*Reflexión: Mateo 4, 12 – 23: Andrés y Pedro abandonan sus redes para seguir al Señor.*

La llamada de Jesús a los primeros discípulos marca un punto significativo en su misión. Mateo presenta este incidente como una indicación de que la misión de Jesús requerirá que otros lo ayuden a difundir la Buena Nueva del Reino. Lo que es aún más asombroso es que estos hombres ordinarios abandonan su ocupación y su equipo y siguen a Jesús. La respuesta de Pedro y los demás es sorprendente. Mateo nos haría creer que la misión de Jesús es tan atractiva que no puede ser ignorada. ¿Cuán dispuestos estamos a hacer lo mismo? ¿Qué nos costaría seguir el Señor con tanto abandono? Jesús comenzó su misión cumpliendo las palabras del gran profeta Isaías. Hoy contemplamos la misión a la que estamos llamados y oramos para que podamos cumplir el plan que Dios tiene para todos nosotros. Así que vamos a sostenerse unos a otros en la luz y la paz de Cristo. Nos regocijamos de que el Señor os haya llamado por su nombre, al igual que los primeros apóstoles: Pedro, Andrés, Santiago y Juan. En todas las épocas, oh Dios, has llamado a hombres y mujeres a seguir el camino de tu Hijo Jesucristo. Danos el valor de seguir su ejemplo en todas las cosas y de servir a los demás sin prejuicios ni expectativas.
