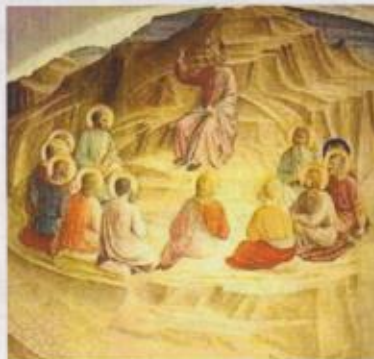

From Pastor's Desk: Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2020.

Reflection: Matthew 5, 13 – 16: You are the salt of the earth and the light of the world.

Jesus uses two domestic images, salt and light, to teach the disciples how important they are in sharing his mission. Notice that Jesus uses an emphatic phrasing: "You are ..." Not, you can be, or you might be, or maybe you will be. No, he is very direct in naming them as salt and light, they are change agents. Just as salt adds flavor to food and light dispels the darkness, so will they transform the world by their witness and their good deeds. In accepting this identity we bring glory to God. With the light of Christ, we bring light to the darkness in our world: injustice, violence, conflict, fear, poverty and countless other shadows. Let us resolve to let the light of Christ shine forth wherever we go and whatever we do.

You have sent your Son, O God, to be a light for the nations and a savior of all people. Grant to us an untiring spirit that we might transform the darkness of the world by actions that are just and merciful. May our light reflect that of your Son our Lord Jesus Christ.

Desde el escritorio del pastor: Quinto domingo en tiempo ordinario 2020.

Reflexión: Mateo 5, 13 – 16: Tú eres la sal de la tierra y la luz del mundo.

Jesús utiliza dos imágenes domésticas, sal y luz, para enseñar a los discípulos lo importantes que son al compartir su misión. Observa que Jesús usa un fraseo enfático: "Tú eres..." No, puedes serlo, o podrías serlo, o tal vez buenas derechos. Al aceptar esta identidad traemos gloria a Dios. Con la luz de Cristo, llevamos luz a las tinieblas de nuestro mundo: injusticia, violencia, conflicto, miedo, pobreza e innumerables sombras. Vamos a resolver a lo seas. No, él es muy directo en nombrarlos como sal y luz, son agentes de cambio. Así como la sal añade sabor a la comida y la luz disipa la oscuridad, también transformarán el mundo por su testimonio y su que la luz de Cristo brille dondequiera que vayamos y hagamos lo que hagamos.

Has enviado a tu Hijo, oh Dios, para ser una luz para las naciones y un salvador de todas las personas. Concédenos un espíritu incansable para transformar las tinieblas del mundo mediante acciones justas y misericordiosas. Que nuestra luz refleje la de tu Hijo nuestro Señor Jesucristo.
