From Pastor's Desk: Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time 2020.

Reflection: Matthew 5, 17 – 37: So it was said to your ancestors; but I say this to you.

In Matthew's Gospel Jesus follows the teaching on the Beatitudes with a number of sayings that begin, "You have heard it said... but I say to you." In these statements Jesus teaches us that there is more to being disciples than just keeping the letter of the law. Jesus asks us to go beyond the words of the law and be attentive to any word or deed that can do harm to another. His examples are ordinary situations in life, but his teaching is rooted in kingdom thinking, not human concepts. Jesus extends the commandments when speaking to his disciples, telling them that they must do more. Let us consider how we can trust Jesus to guide us in our daily life. Our hope and prayer is that we will be counted among those whom God calls "Blessed."

O God of heaven and earth, you have sent your Son, the Word made flesh to teach us your ways and lead us to eternal life. Grant us the wisdom to know your law and the courage to be its witness to the end of time.

Desde el escritorio del pastor: Sexto domingo en el tiempo ordinario 2020.

Reflexión: Mateo 5, 17 – 37: Así se dijo a vuestros antepasados; pero te digo esto.

En el Evangelio de Mateo Jesús sigue la enseñanza sobre las Bienaventuranzas con una serie de dichos que comienzan, "Usted ha oído decir..., pero yo le digo." En estas declaraciones Jesús nos enseña que hay más en ser discípulos que simplemente guardar la letra de la ley. Jesús nos pide que vayamos más allá de las palabras de la ley y seamos atentos a cualquier palabra o hecho que pueda hacer daño a otro. Sus ejemplos son situaciones ordinarias en la vida, pero su enseñanza está arraigada en el pensamiento del reino, no en los conceptos humanos. Jesús extiende los mandamientos al hablar a sus discípulos, diciéndoles que deben hacer más. Consideremos cómo podemos confiar en Jesús para guiarnos en nuestra vida diaria. Nuestra esperanza y oración es que seamos contados entre aquellos a quienes Dios llama "Bendito".

Oh Dios del cielo y de la tierra, has enviado a tu Hijo, el Verbo hecho carne para enseñarnos tus caminos y guiarnos a la vida eterna. Concédenos la sabiduría de conocer tu ley y el valor de ser su testimonio del fin de los tiempos.
