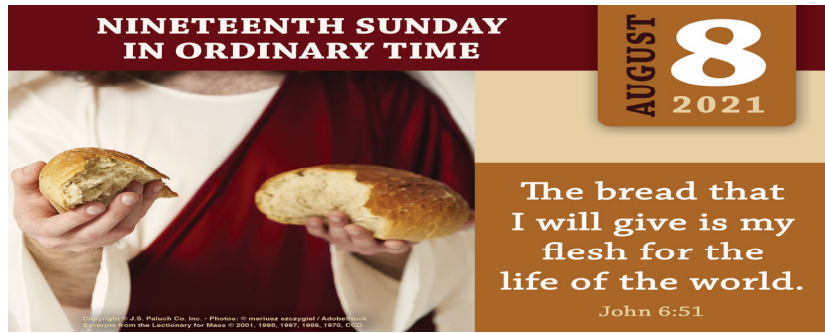

Sacrament of Penance Saturdays from 4:00 to 4:45pm or by appointment. The Sacrament is to be celebrated anonymously, behind the screen only. A mask must be worn at all times while inside the Church for those not fully vaccinated.

Sacrament of Baptism The celebration of infant Baptism will be scheduled individually with each family having a child to be baptized. Parents will be expected to participate in a Baptismal Preparation session. Prep classes are held the third Monday of each month at 7 pm. Contact the Parish Office to reserve your spot.

Sacrament of Matrimony At least one party of the couple must be a registered parishioner and a fully initiated practicing Catholic. Contact the parish priest of your choice at least six months in advance of the desired wedding date to arrange for marriage preparation.

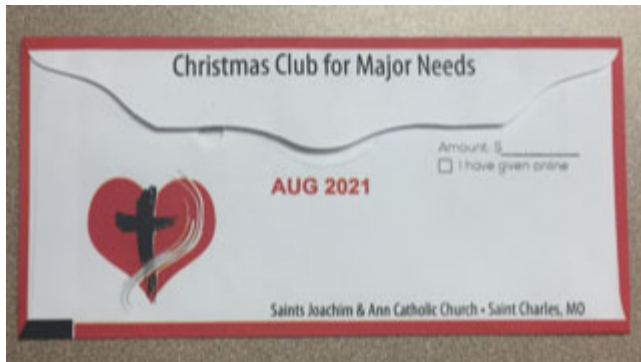
A new face in the Parish Office!...

possible to consolidate some of our parish office responsibilities. This has made it possible also to downsize our staff in the ongoing interest and pursuit of good and responsible stewardship.

Dana Puckett has been working for the past year in our PSR Office and has been with the PSR Program for 20 years. She will continue to do that three days a week and will be working another two days a week in our Parish Office.

Speaking of ongoing good stewardship...Please don't forget about our *Christmas Club for Major Needs*!!!!



As I hope you are aware, since 2007 we have accomplished a great deal and made Herculean financial strides as a parish without having need for our own capital campaign at any point in time. In case you've forgotten, here's a snapshot.

- the elimination of \$2.6million in construction debt from 2007 until February 2018.
- the replacement of the roof on the junior high building, the roof on the elementary school building, and finally also the roof on the church in the aggregate amount of \$1.5million
- the re-grading, landscaping, and completion of our parish frontage, the repaving of the entirety of our parking lots, and the replacement of the railroad tie retaining wall on the northwest corner of the rectory with a versa-lock stone wall in the aggregate amount of over \$600,000
- the increase of our parish subsidy to our parish school from \$100,000 a

year to now \$490,000 a year in order to keep tuition as affordable as possible ■ now, the completion of the interior of our church in the amount of \$1.4million without borrowing one cent or creating any new debt ■ and, finally, reaching the point of having 4.8 months' worth of operating expenses in the bank in unrestricted parish savings (\$965,000) ... getting closer and closer to achieving best practice standards of having at least six months' worth of operating expenses in savings.

All of this has been made possible by your support of our *Christmas Club for Major Needs* in addition to your support of the weekly Sunday Offering. It is the *Christmas Club for Major Needs* which has funded all of the debt reduction we have accomplished and all of the capital improvements and repairs we have made. That has allowed our operating budget, which is primarily funded by the Sunday Offering, to increase our support of our school and continue to make possible the wide range of Ministries and Services which comprise parish life.

Now that the church interior project is complete, please do not take this as an occasion to think that our *Christmas Club for Major Needs* is no longer necessary or no longer needs everyone's support. Much to the contrary!

As a first example, this summer the HVAC units which serve the western addition to our church have broken and need to be replaced. Their replacement will cost \$35,000. Though we still likely think of the additions to church and the parish center as "new," having been built in 2005-2006 they are now approaching 16 years old. All of the HVAC for those structures is likewise that old. The same applies, too, to all of the rooftop HVAC units on our junior high and elementary school. They were all added and installed during that same construction project and are nearing the end of their life expectancy. The anticipated cost of eventually replacement them all will exceed \$250,000. It will only be our continued, steady, little by little, ongoing support of the *Christmas Club for Major Needs* that will make it possible for us to continue to accomplish great things and to cover great costs without ever needing to conduct a capital campaign which would entail a one-time huge sacrificial ask. As you know, I believe that a little bit at a time is a much more feasible avenue of approach to saving and covering costs.

The goal for the *Christmas Club for Major Needs* remains the same. In the ideal it is an average \$50/month or \$600/year from every household in addition to your Sunday Offering. Some people take care of this at tax return time. Some do it when they get an annual bonus at work. Some do it month by month or even week by week so that they don't end up spending the money on something else. Whatever works for you, works for us. The biggest thing is that we are *each* doing what we can so that the responsibility is one shared by us all.

If you haven't been supportive of the Christmas Club for Major Needs lately, I respectfully ask that you give your support of it your renewed prayerful consideration and that you be as generously supportive as you are able.

Thanks a million for all you do to make parish life possible. Remember our Stewardship Prayer: *My parish is comprised of people like me. I help make it what it is...So I commit myself to being all things that I want my parish to be!*

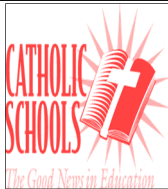

- Register for an updated background screening.
- View two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct.
- Agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct.

Please go to preventandprotectstl.org. Click on Register. Enter Passcode/Organization Code: **stlprotect**. Select Parish or Parish School for Location Category, scroll down to the bottom of the Parish/Location drop down menu and select Sts. Joachim and Ann Parish and School. Enter your personal information.
